


VEHICULAR POLICY

KLUANE DRILLING LTD. is aware of the serious potential risks involved in driving vehicles which is why it is committed to a safety system to control and minimize vehicular risks that could cause incidents affecting its workers, community, interested parties, and company property in every country where it has operations.

As a result of this, the company establishes the following:

- ◆ Every subsidiary must implement vehicular controls to ensure safe driving.
- ◆ Every subsidiary provides training and encourages all workers to drive safely.
- ◆ Workers are prohibited from driving without the experience, authorization, proper license, insurance and competency to drive safely.
- ◆ Workers are prohibited from driving while intoxicated or under the effects of alcohol, marijuana, drugs, or psychoactive substances.
- ◆ Safe work procedures are established and must be followed for contracting vehicles and hiring drivers.
- ◆ Preventive and corrective vehicular maintenance is performed on all the vehicles, including those belonging to contractors.
- ◆ Drivers must obey all local regulations and laws.
- ◆ Drivers are not allowed to use electronic devices that could cause a distraction while driving.
- ◆ The wearing of seat belts at all times by the driver and all passengers is mandatory.
- ◆ The vehicles must be parked without risk of rolling down hills and the emergency brake must be activated. It is best to park on flat ground and the driver must be in the vehicle if the engine is running.
- ◆ Cargo must be secure and loose items must not be transported in the cargo box and especially not in the cabin.
- ◆ It is prohibited to modify or disconnect any safety device installed in the vehicle.
- ◆ Every subsidiary must define hours of vehicle operation to reduce driver fatigue.
